Add a transaction queue observer at application launch Query the App Store for product information before presenting your app's store UI

Provide a UI for restoring products



Advanced NSOperations

WWDC 2015

NSOPERATION

- Simple, well-known API override main, add to an NSOperationQueue
- Cancellable
- Supports dependencies between operations
- completion block
- NSOperations are abstract, add what you need in subclasses

NSOPERATIONS IN VIEW CONTROLLERS

- View Controllers have a reference to an NSOperationQueue
- Complicated model stuff / networking in NSOperation "get from/post to API" subclasses
- Inspect error custom property on completion
- Model changes are propagated to the UI via Core Data notifications

Core Data

CORE DATA

- Object graph and persistence framework
- Since 2005
- Updated annually (tons of great stuff in iOS 10 and Xcode 8)

CORE DATA MIGRATIONS

- SQLite store
- Changes over time mean the underlying schema changes
- Core Data offers several ways to migrate data, automatic works in many cases but may need to create a mapping or write code
- But the best way is to not migrate at all
